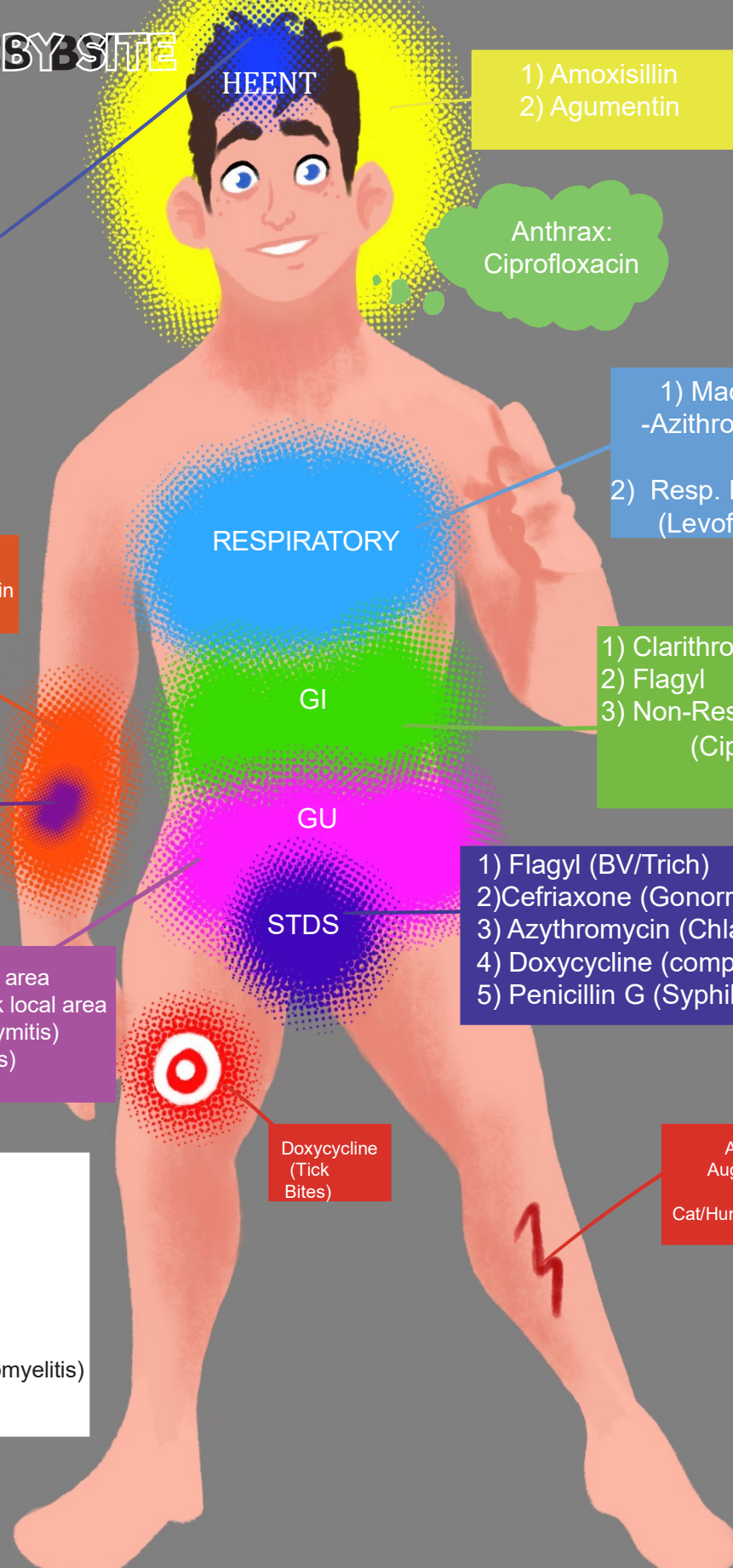

GU

- 1) Flagyl (BV/Trich)
- 2) Ceftriaxone (Gonorrhea)
- 3) Azithromycin (Chlamydia)
- 4) Doxycycline (complicated Chlamydia)
- 5) Penicillin G (Syphilis)

STDS

- 1) Bactrim (UTI) - Check local area
- 2) Nitrofurantoin (UTI) - Check local area
- 3) Ciprofloxacin (pyelo/Epididymitis)
- 4) Ceftriaxone (Acute Prostatitis)

- Acute Bronchitis
- Allergic Rhinitis
