CNS: The brain, brain stem, and the spinal cord. To specify the spinal cord, the medulla, the pons, the cerebellum, the midbrain, the diencephalon, and the cerebral hemispheres

PNS: Peripheral nerves, neuromuscular junctions, cranial nerves, and spinal nerves.
