Interesting Flint Water

- I. Flint switched water sources in order to cut costs.
- II. Thousands of children have been exposed to lead.

Affects on the He System

- I. Highlighted the importance of collecting data that facilitates action and decision making for the prevention of lead poisoning.
- II. The Flint Registry was granted public health authority status by the CDC, which has facilitated data-sharing agreements by allowing entities to share data with the registry without obtaining individual authorization.
- III. Partnerships between private, public, and nonprofit organizations provide opportunities for collaboration that can help guide innovative strategies for primary lead prevention, raise awareness, extend outreach and communication efforts, and promote a shared sense of ownership.
