- Assess capillary refill: Fingers

Capillary refill assessment is utilized to assess perfusion and oxygen in the peripheral circulation volume.

- Assess capillary refill: Toes

Capillary refill assessment is utilized to assess perfusion and oxygen in the peripheral circulation volume. Your client has burns to the feet and the circulation can be altered due to the damage of the vessels.

- Inspect extremities: Lower

Assessing the burns is critical in order to determine the stages of healing and to prevent infection. Burns cause an immediate inflammatory response and with the stages of 2nd and 3rd degree burns the skin's protective barrier, epidermis, has been destroyed and risk for infection, fluid loss, and alterations in perfusion to the site can occur. The risk for infection is high for burns and increases due to the area affected for this client.

- Inspect skin

Skin assessment is essential for this client due to the exposure of extreme heat and environmental temperatures which contributed to sun exposure and risk for sunburn and dehydration.

- Palpate extremities: Lower

Palpation of the lower extremities is an essential physical assessment due to the presence of injury to tissues and open wounds. Pain, tenderness, and edema can affect the healing of the wounds due to altered tissue perfusion
