1. Suspicion while percussing the liver: Percussion that changes from dull to tympany as you percuss from the left anterior axillary line to the left sternal border
2. 26 y/o pt, assessing ROM of the shoulder: rotator cuff injury
3. Unequal shoulder height and lateral curvature of the spine: Scoliosis
4. What is that awful taste: Gustatory
5. 43 y/o male patient with macrocytic anemia: Vit B12
6. 24 y/o erythema on face : doxycycline
7. 28 y/o male pt Hyperthyroidism testing: TSH and free T4
8. 22 year old pt systematic lupus SLE: Butterfly rash on face
9. Elderly man h/o Ehlers Danlos of retinal detachment gas pneumopexy: posterior only
10. Highest level of research quality: Systematic review
11. Hyperthyroid crisis: Tachycardia
12. Second oral anti-diabetic agent: HGB A1c 8.0
13. Drug never be used as monotherapy for asthma management: Long acting beta antagonist
14. 18 y/o complaining of hematuria post strep infection: Glomerulonephritis
15. Enlarged object remarked that to needs be removed: Thymic remnant
16. PT with PAD benefit from what agent: Cilostazol (pletal)
17. Gag reflex impaired in cancer pt: glossopharyngeal
18. SSRI SNRI MAOI must be individualized due to the risk of : serotonin Syndrome

30. Mediterranean pt with microcytic anemia: thalassemia
31. Firm contraindication contraceptive use:
History of migraine with aura
32. 84 y/o overdosed on Norvasc cause of renal issues: acute tubular necrosis

34. Benign lesion stuck to skin: Seborrheic Keratosis
35. Confirms Dx of pyelonephritis: WBC casts on urinalysis with microscopy
36. 48 y/o pt with floaters and flashes of light signs of: Retinal detachment
37. PT in rehab is despondent hart time being wakeful : Situational depression
38. 62 y/o pt gnawing abd pain hx of orthopedic overdose injuries rule out: Have you been taking NSAIDS lately?
39. 63 year old patient chest pressure numbness tingling SOB diagnose and plan for: Unstable angina tx with sublingual nitroglycerin and order a cardiac stress test.
40. Dermatologic lesions are precancerous due to UV-B exposure: Actinic Keratosis
41. 53 year old female pt assess transmission of voice sounds hear nasally an A instead of a mufÒe E: positive for egophony
42. 31 y/o female with lateral lower back pain bacteria in urine culture has gram neg rods least likely: enterococcus
43. 19 year old sexually active female shufÒing gait: Pelvic inflammatory disease treat for gonorrhea and chlamydia
44. Agent that contracts the afferent arteriole of administration: Ibuprofen (advil)
