- 2) Which drug(s) are recommended to treat infants with UTI?
  - Ampicillin and gentamycin
  
- 3) Which representative abo is NOT a bacteriostatic inhibitors of protein synthesis?
  - Vancomycin or Clindamycin (not sure which one)
  
- 4) Which abo drug class is it acceptable to prescribe without first obtaining a culture and sensitivity?
  - Macrolides
  
- 5) Which abo drug class should not be used in children younger than 8 years because it may cause permanent discoloration of teeth?
  - Tetracyclines
  
- 6) Which abo drug class can cause kernicterus in infants when systemic drugs in the class are taken in the first trimester of pregnancy?
  - Sulfonamides
  
- 7) Which abo drug class listed is known for all drugs within the class promoting the development of a C. Diff infection?
  - Cephalosporin
  
- 8) Trimethoprim should be avoided in pts with which deficiency?
  - Folate
  
- 9) Which drug class is contraindicated for UTI in the third trimester of pregnancy and in older adults with decreases renal function?
  - Nitrofurantoin
