- Family history that includes a close relative with an eating disorder, weight stigma in the culture or family, trauma (especially physical or sexual abuse), and a history of being bullied about weight or physical appearance may increase the risk for eating disorders.
- Mild BMI Less than or equal to 17 kg/m². Moderate BMI 16 to 16.99 kg/m². Severe BMI 15 to 15.99 kg/m². Extreme BMI Less than 15 kg/m²
- Anorexia and bulimia can both have medical complications of menstrual irregularities and dehydration.
- 57% of transgender youth with unsupportive parents attempt suicide.
- One commonly used SBIRT tool is the CRAFFT screening tool, which is recommended by the AAP Bright Futures Guidelines for preventative care screenings.
