1. A patient who is refusing psychiatric treatment has their case adjudicated. The judge orders treatment over objection for the good of the patient. Which ethical principle is trumped?

Autonomy

2. A PMHNP is working with a nonprofit organization to implement a public health campaign aimed at reducing the stigma of mental illness. Which role of the PMHNP best describes this activity?

Advocacy

3. A PMHNP employed within a small telehealth practice routinely "curb side consults" a collaborative psychiatrist within the same state through email. Yes, this became a HIPAA violation when she put the client's name in the title subject line.

HIPAA privacy laws include telehealth and email technologies. The client's name should not be in the subject line. Email sent outside of an organization must be encrypted. In this case, the email is within the same organization
