The *Journal of Nursing Scholarship* focuses on submission of scholarly works in the areas of clinical scholarship, health policy and systems, profession and society and world health that align with all areas practice change initiatives often seen in DNP projects (Gennaro, 2024). The mission of JNS is to advance knowledge that improves the health of the world's people. JNS is most interested in receiving manuscripts that provide new knowledge designed to improve nursing practice globally (Gennaro, 2024).
