The Problem

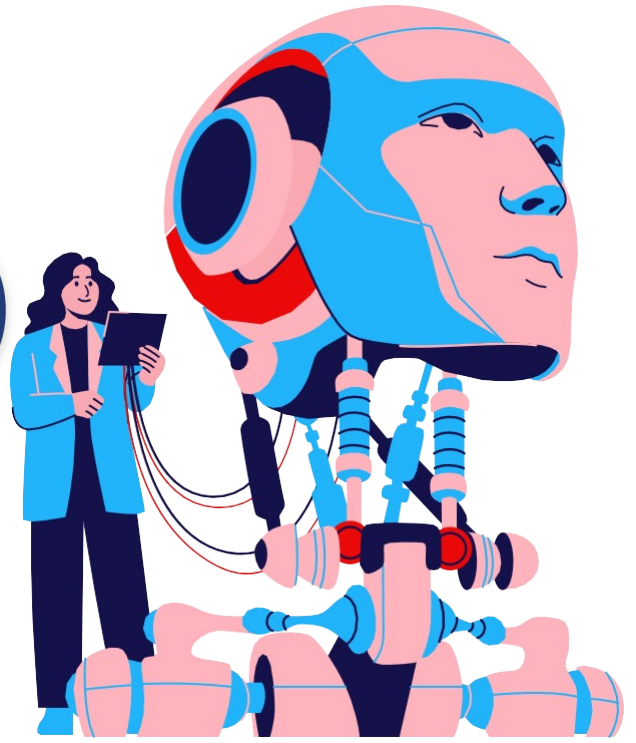
